

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions
April 6, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 63 (22-23) AS AMENDED** An Ordinance to amend Section 161.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, titled Sick Leave, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 234 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 236 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of 400 tons of rock salt for use by the Street Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 237 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend the Salary Step Schedule of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to increase the salary and job description, for the position of the City Engineer and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 238 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with CT Consultants of Columbus, Ohio, to provide professional engineering services for the Colegate Drive Sewershed Study and Design Project, in an amount not to exceed \$260,000.00, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 240 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 943.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 241 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to pay Ryan Boley, Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations Manager, an amount not to exceed \$9,929.63, for overtime hours worked by him, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 242 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into Change Order No. 8 to the present contract between the City of Marietta, Ohio and Pickering Associates of Parkersburg, WV, for necessary changes to the Marietta River Trail Phase V Land Slip and Soldier Pile Wall Failure Repair Project, in an amount not to exceed \$17,500.00, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 245 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into contracts with three (3) different companies for the Marietta City Garage Upgrade Project, to-wit: Morrison, Inc. for heating and air conditioning in the amount of \$10,634.30; R. W. Miller Plumbing & Electric, Inc. for remodel of bathroom in the amount of \$15,370.00; and Eco Shine Polishing, Inc., for floor resurfacing in the amount of \$7,800.00, for a grand total amount not to exceed \$33,804.30; using American Rescue Plan Act Funds, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 246 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for the application of asphalt to various streets in the City of Marietta, Ohio and to replace/install ADA curb ramps, as part of the City's 2023 City-Wide Asphalt Resurfacing and ADA Curb Ramp Project, and to direct that the Director of Public Safety and Service return said bids with his recommendation for acceptance to the Marietta City Council within fifteen days of the bid opening and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 247 (22-23)** An Ordinance adopted by the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio wherein the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation for the Installation and Upgrading of Existing Infrastructure for an Interconnected Traffic Signal System at Six (6) Intersections Within the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 248 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into a contract with Perram Electric, Inc. of Wadsworth, Ohio, for the Street Garage Fiber Installation Project, in an amount not to exceed \$20,563.00, using American Rescue Plan Act Funds; and further repealing Ordinance No. 218 (22-23), passed on February 16, 2023; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 249 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 250 (22-23)** An Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 186 (22-23) in its entirety; and further authorizing the City of Marietta, Ohio to pick up the statutorily required contribution to the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) for all the employees of the Teamsters Union #637, pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Section 414(h)(2), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 251 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to allocate and/or set aside a portion of monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund, to be used for the Marietta Fiber Optics Project – Phase 2, in an amount not to exceed \$166,000.00; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 84 (22-23)** A Resolution to request a donation of grant monies from the Marietta Community Foundation, a non-profit organization, on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio and the Marietta City Tree Commission. Said donation shall be in the amount of \$783.00 and disbursed from the William McKinney Memorial Tree Fund. Said monies shall to be used for the purchase and planting of trees in the Fall of 2023 within the city limits of Marietta, Ohio under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service. Furthermore, this Resolution shall be to accept said donation of monies with the sincere appreciation and thanks of the City of Marietta, Ohio, Marietta City Council and the Marietta City Tree Commission to the William McKinney Memorial Tree Fund and the Marietta Community Foundation for this generous donation of monies.
- **Resolution No. 92 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public, Safety and Service to designate the pollinator garden/zone located at 510 Fort Street, in the

City of Marietta, Ohio, as the Hoffert & Henderhan Memorial Garden located at 510 Fort Street, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Resolution No. 93 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public, Safety and Service to accept an Artistic Seating Bench, to be installed on City property in the Hoffert & Henderhan Memorial Garden located at 510 Fort Street, in the City of Marietta, Ohio, pursuant to the requirements of the Marietta Park Bench Donation Program Specification guidelines, with said bench being generously donated by the Washington County Health Department and the Appalachian Ohio Falls Prevention Program, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 243 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Kelly-Creswell of Springfield, Ohio, and Sourcewell of Staples, Minnesota, for the acquisition of one (1) John Deere ProGator with Mounted Airless Miniliner Paint Striping Equipment, for use by the Street Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost not to exceed \$104,031.08 under the auspices of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act, as administered by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 244 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Sherwin-Williams of Marietta, Ohio, for the acquisition of one (1) Thermo Plastic Striper for use by the Street Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost not to exceed \$24,824.00 and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 252 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to sign an F Permit Application on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to give the City's consent for the sale and consumption of beer in the Ohio River Parking Lot owned by the City of Marietta, Ohio. Said permit is to be filed with the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, by Marietta Riverfront Roar, Inc. In the event said F Permit Application is granted by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, the City of Marietta, Ohio will temporarily waive the operation of Section 529.07(b)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, that prohibits opened containers of beer in public places, for the covered premises for the duration of the event covered by the F Permit so issued, and declaring an EMERGENCY
- **Ordinance No. 253 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 702.06(c) [Returns Required] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, in order to change the penalty-amount for vendors who fail to timely file a return under the City of Marietta, Ohio's pertaining to Transient Guest Tax, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 254 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 702.071(a) [Interest and Penalties], of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, in order to change the penalty-interest-

rate for vendors who have an unpaid balance under the City of Marietta, Ohio's Ordinances pertaining to Transient Guest Tax, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 256 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 257 (22-23)** An Ordinance to declare the existence of a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and its municipal utility, the Wastewater Department, as the result of the 30-inch diameter sanitary sewer line collapse which creates an unhealthy condition that detrimentally affects the citizens of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and the City of Marietta, Ohio's financial condition; and, therefore, to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract without formal bidding, advertising, and quality based selection, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 735.051 and 153.71(B), with Mack Industries, Valley City, Ohio for the completion of the City of Marietta East Norwood Pump Station and Sanitary Sewer Collapse Emergency Repair Project, at a price not to exceed
- **Ordinance No. 258 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend the current Table of Organization for the City of Marietta, Ohio, for purposes of establishing a seasonal position of Harbor Master for the Marietta Harbor, and for establishing the salary, duties, responsibilities, qualifications and requirements of said seasonal Harbor Master, who shall serve under the direct supervision of the Director of the Public Safety and Service, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 260 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 261 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Resolution No. 90 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize Marietta Moose Lodge No. 1823, to install, under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service, a book box at the corner of Post Street and West Butler Street, near the Marietta Harbor.
- **Resolution No. 91 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio to establish and designate the National Opioid Abatement Trust Fund, as a fund for the City of Marietta, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 96 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the City of Marietta, Ohio to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with ABM Building Value, for a Preliminary Assessment of the City's facilities, at no cost to the City.
- **Resolution No. 97 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize Girl Scout Troop 10148 to undertake a landscaping project on the grounds of Gold Star Park under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 98 (22-23)** A Resolution for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to accept a donation of real property from Caleb T. Gammon, with said real property being located at 901 and 903 Jahn Street, Marietta, Washington County, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
