

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions
March 2, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 194 (22-23)** An Ordinance to create three (3) seasonal laborer positions at the Marietta Harbor, in the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 195 (22-23)** An Ordinance to create four (4) additional seasonal laborer positions in the Public Works Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 211 (22-23)** An Ordinance to create up to three (3) seasonal positions in the Police Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 212 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend the Salary Schedule to increase salaries in the Office of the Civil Service Commission of the City of Marietta, Ohio, effective April 1, 2023.
- **Ordinance No. 221 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, or contracts, for the mowing, trimming, and policing of certain properties owned by, or under the control of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 222 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Hi-Vac Corporation of Marietta, Ohio, and Sourcewell of Staples, Minnesota, for the acquisition of one (1) Jetter Truck for use by the Wastewater Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost not to exceed \$179,870.00 under the auspices of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act, as administered by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 223 (22-23)** An Ordinance to find and determine that a 2001 Case Skid Steer owned by the City of Marietta, Ohio, and used by the Waste Water Department, is personal property not needed for any municipal purpose and to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the sale thereof pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 224 (22-23)** An Ordinance to approve the authorization of expenditures from the American Rescue Plan Act Funds in an amount not to exceed \$315,000.00 and to enter into an agreement with Marietta Main Street, for the revitalization of downtown Marietta, through events, programs, and initiatives in caring for downtown businesses, buildings, and infrastructure, and Declaring and EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 225 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Board of Commissioners of Washington County, Ohio, wherein the City of Marietta, Ohio agrees to assist the Board of Commissioners with the project management of the planning and design of the “Connecting Residents on Safer Streets (CROSS) Marietta Project” and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 226 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 227 (22-23)** An Ordinance to approve the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio.
- **Ordinance No. 228 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to allocate and/or set aside a portion of monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund, to be used for the Marietta City Police Department Upgrade Project, in an amount not to exceed \$199,670.49, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 229 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into contracts with four (4) different companies for the Marietta City Police Department Upgrade Project, in a total amount not to exceed \$199,670.49; using American Rescue Plan Act Funds, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 82 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Department of Transportation for a grant under the 2023 Safe Routes to School Program, for monies for the City of Marietta’s Safe Routes to School Project (Infrastructure Improvements) and declaring an EMERGENCY.

March 15, 2023

- **Resolution No. 83 (22-23) AS AMENDED** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Mayor to apply on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio for the FY 2024 Community Project Funding Grant, for funds to be used for the Start Westward, East Muskingum Park Restoration and Improvement Project – Phase II, for the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

March 16, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 217 (22-23)** An Ordinance to vacate the platted/undeveloped portion of Van Bergen Avenue, South of the intersection of Maine Street, in the City of Marietta, Ohio.
- **Ordinance No. 220 (22-23)** An Ordinance to create four (4) temporary seasonal laborer positions in the Public Works Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 230 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Board of Education of the Marietta City School District, wherein the City of Marietta, Ohio agrees to work with the Marietta City School District on projects partially funded, or fully funded, by the Ohio Department of Transportation, through the 2023 Safe Routes To School Grant Program, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 231 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into a contract with Ohio Valley Archaeology, Inc. of Columbus, Ohio, for the Mound Cemetery Geophysical Survey, Mapping and Grave Locating Project, in an amount not to exceed \$49,327.29; using American Rescue Plan Act Funds, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 232 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for the leasing of Room 12 (250 sq. ft.) in the Marietta Area Community Center at the Armory in the City of Marietta, Ohio, and to direct that the Director of Public Safety and Service return said bids with his recommendation for acceptance to the Marietta City Council within fifteen (15) days of the bid opening, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 233 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for the Marietta City Fire Department Station One (1) Expansion Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 235 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into a contract with J. Trent King, d.b.a. King Dirt and Pipe of Waterford, Ohio, for the Marietta Community Dog Park at Jackson Hill Drainage Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 85 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public, Safety and Service to install or place a six (6) foot Pullman Bench with back package plaque, on behalf of Jan Tanner, on City property in Gold Star Park, pursuant to the requirements of the Marietta Park Bench Donation Program Specification guideline.
- **Resolution No. 86 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for a design loan for the Duck Creek Interceptor Renewal Project, (Infrastructure Improvements) and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 87 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for a design loan for the Colegate Drive I/I Improvements Project, (Infrastructure Improvements) and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 88 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Eagle Scout Project of Jack Tindall, member of Troop 207, to be completed on the grounds of the Marietta Area Community Center at the Armory.

- **Resolution No. 89 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Eagle Scout Project of Cole Stein, member of Troop 207, to be completed on the grounds of Indian Acres Park.
