City of Marietta, Ohio Allocation: \$117,860

This program is funded through the Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) with funds allocated through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009. The intent of the program is to put these funds to use quickly. In selecting activities for CDBG-R funding, the City is to give priority to activities which can be under contract within 120 days of grant award.

The full range of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) eligible activities and projects may generally be funded. The ARRA directs the City to use these funds to maximize job creation and economic benefit and in addition, certain types of activities are prohibited from receiving ARRA funding: casinos or other gambling facilities, aquariums, zoos, golf courses, or swimming pools.

The City is proposing to use the recovery funds to fund the following activities:

Activity Name: ADA Curb Ramps

Activity Narrative: This citywide project provides handicapped accessible sidewalk curb ramps to improve access and remove barriers in residential and commercial districts. The City intends to begin the bid process for the ramp work the first week of June, 2009 and award a contract within 60 days from bid opening. The project will thus have an immediate economic benefit by providing short term construction jobs and a long term economic benefit by improving the built environment in our city.

Jobs Created: approximately 14 jobs for one month duration

Activity Name: Buckeye Park Resurfacing

Activity Narrative: This project provides repairs and resurfacing to the existing pavement in Buckeye Park in the Norwood neighborhood. The City intends to begin the bid process for the surfacing work the first week of July, 2009 and award a contract within 60 days from bid opening. The project will thus have an immediate economic benefit by providing short term construction jobs and a long term economic benefit by improving the built environment in our city.

Jobs Created: approximately 7 jobs for one month duration

These activities will be implemented by the City of Marietta Engineering Department. The project contact person is Joe Tucker, City Engineer, 304 Putnam St., Marietta, OH 45750, Ph.: 740-373-5495

This proposed street work is in addition to the annual allocation of CDBG funds that City receives each year. The ARRA requires that the CDBG-R funds be tracked and accounted for separately from its annual allocation of CDBG funds.

Citizen Participation and Public Comment

The City must submit a substantial amendment to their Consolidated Plan 2008 Annual Action Plan to identify the planned uses for these funds. An ad soliciting public comment on the use of the CDBG-R funds will be in the May 15, 2009 edition of the Marietta Times. The required 7 day public comment period will begin on May 20, 2009 and end on May 26, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. The program's descriptions and details will be available for public examination on May 19th in the following locations: Community Development Department on the 1st floor of 304 Putnam St., Marietta, Ohio 45750, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday; Washington County Library, 615 5th St., Marietta, Ohio 45750, Monday-Thursday 9 a.m.-8:30p.m., Friday-Saturday 9 a.m.-5 p.m. The plan will also be posted on the City web site: www.mariettaoh.net. All interested agencies, groups and persons are invited to submit comments for consideration by the City to the Community Development Department at the aforementioned address. All comments must be submitted in writing with a valid name and address. The City will submit an application for the funds to HUD on or before June 5, 2009. All comments and responses will be posted to HUD along with the application for funds.

Formal City Council action with an effective date of May 22, 2009, regarding this proposed amendment will take place on May 21, 2009 at the regularly

scheduled City Council meeting.
