

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE: CDBG 2021-2023 Consolidated Plan, associated 2021 Action Plan and Substantial Amendment to 2019 Action Plan

The Marietta Development Department has prepared the City's 2021-2023 Consolidated Plan and associated 2021 Action Plan. The purpose of the Consolidated Plan is to assess community needs, develop priorities, and create a longer-term strategic vision to use Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. The Action Plan relates to the first year of the Consolidated Plan. The focus of CDBG is the improvement of living circumstances for low-to-moderate income (LMI) persons, both through housing-related assistance and improvements to the suitability of living environments. The 2021-2023 Consolidated Plan seeks to advance these objectives by funding home rehabilitation assistance, infrastructure improvement, neighborhood revitalization, transportation support and homeless assistance.

The Marietta Development Department also proposes to substantially amend the City's 2019 Action Plan to apply for available CDBG-CV funding to be administered by Community Action in providing rental and utilities assistance to qualifying applicants.

The City's Consolidated Plan, associated 2021 Action Plan, and the proposed substantial amendment to the 2019 Action Plan will be considered at a City Council committee meeting on June 23, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. in Armory Community Room 10, 241 Front St. Council as a whole will thereafter consider the adoption of legislation to endorse the filing with HUD of the Consolidated Plan and associated 2021 Action Plan and the substantial amendment to the 2019 Action Plan, with such legislation anticipated to receive three readings on July 1, July 15 and August 5 (barring action of Council to accelerate readings or change hearing dates). Each full City Council meeting in consideration of the resolution will be held in the Armory Building Community Room 10 at 7:30 p.m.

Starting on June 26 and through July 26, 2021, the drafts of the Consolidated Plan, associated 2021 Action Plan and substantially amended 2019 Action Plan may be viewed electronically on the City of Marietta's Community Development webpage, or in hard copy in the Marietta Development Department office in 304 Putnam St., 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Comments on any of these plans received during this period ending July 26 will be included with the final plans to be filed with HUD, and can be emailed to [deverson@mariettaoh.net](mailto:deverson@mariettaoh.net), mailed in hard copy or hand-delivered to 304 Putnam St., Marietta, OH 45750. Oral comments on any of the plans will also be received at a public hearing to be held in the Armory Building, 241 Front Street, Community Room 10 on Monday, July 12 at 2:00 p.m. At that hearing, the Development Department will also give a public summary of the contents of the Consolidated Plan, 2021 Action Plan and substantially amended 2019 Action Plan before commentary is requested.
